## **Absolute integration** without limits.

IPure is a completely open video intercom system, based on standard IP network protocols; for this reason it is able to communicate with a variety of devices for optimal feature management and maximisation of the user experience.


There are many systems on the market that, although defined as IP, are not able to fulfil the primary functionality and purpose of this technology, that is, the **free and total integration** with third-party systems.

We are talking about systems that run along a network cable and promise communication and integration with other devices but, in reality, integration is limited to proprietary devices.

On the one hand, the limitations that characterise them do not allow dialogue with third-party products and consequently the professional must use the same brand for all the systems that the latter intends to integrate into the system, without being able to freely choose based on preference.

On the other hand, it is not possible to obtain the solutions and results desired by the user, who expects communication between systems aimed at increased comfort of use.

This is why IPure is the ultimate solution to create integrated systems without any restrictions and with great performance.







#### **IPure** Multi-protocol

The main protocols most often used to integrate different devices and systems into the same network infrastructure and to allow for internal communication between such devices are implemented in all IPure devices: **the results are system solutions without limits and maximum performance**.

**SIP Protocol** for interfacing with VoIP switchboards, which are now the most used in the business and hospitality sectors, and with Public Address broadcasting systems.


**RTSP Protocol** for integration with IP video surveillance systems: you can view the video streams of the video cameras directly on the video intercom or pick up the video stream from the entry panel to link it with a video surveillance system.

**HTTP** to manage all outdoor and indoor station commands and services on third-party platforms.

#### **Proprietary Videx Protocol**

In the case of a system that does not require interfacing with other systems, **IPure devices** communicate with each other through the proprietary Videx protocol allowing for instant self-learning devices, advanced configurations with the IPure Wizard, and considerable time savings.

The Videx protocol is constantly updated with the evolution of market needs, thus ensuring updates with features aimed at increasing comfort and services for the user. Moreover, the updates are free from licensing constraints and compatible with all devices, even older ones.

#### No license to use

All the features that characterise the IPure system in its maximum interoperability are available by default on each device, to allow professionals to **integrate IPure with third-party systems without any restrictions or additional costs**: home automation, VoIP telephony, video surveillance and security.

#### **Ultra performance** for larger more complex systems

IPure is not only the solution to create integrated systems, but it is ideal for use in all those applications characterised by large distances, which are extensive and complex, with a high number of users.

In fact, IPure has no distance limits and no user limits, it is also an open, scalable and implementable system at any time: you can tailor the system to your personal needs and it is possible to make subsequent changes and integrations.

It is the video intercom system that allows you to create extensive systems, articulated and characterised by numerous services to be managed, such as the **concierge switchboard** or **condominium video surveillance**.







# The first plug & play video intercom for FTTH GPON systems

IPure is the first plug & play video intercom system that can be installed on FTTH GPON infrastructures to create multi-service systems.


In these systems, the IPure video intercom runs along other services on the same single fibre that reaches from the control unit to the housing unit: no additional fibre or traditional wiring is needed and no additional conversion devices or other accessories are needed.

To install IPure in an FTTH GPON infrastructure, simply connect the outdoor station via UTP cable directly to the OLT, where other technologies also converge, and connect the indoor stations to the ONT/ONU via the same type of cable.

On the other hand, all other video intercom systems sold as IP, to be installed in a system with FTTH GPON technology, require the installation of separate wiring because they are not standard Ethernet.

This means that they CANNOT travel at the same time as the other services within the same fibre that reaches the housing unit, thus forcing users to set up an additional local control unit and an additional fibre dedicated to the video intercom.

With IPure, you create a complete video intercom system on the same fibre optic infrastructure and with a single fibre cable up to the housing unit; the configuration is extremely simple, moreover the savings are considerable in terms of time spent and costs, even for the end user.







#### With IPure, integration is free and unrestricted with all third-party systems.

It supports the main protocols used to allow multiple devices and systems to communicate with each other: HTTP, RTSP, VoIP.

This makes it the video intercom system suitable for applications that require absolute interoperability between systems for the creation of cutting-edge technological solutions. There are no distance limits, thus it is ideal for solutions characterised by large, varied spaces.

IPure is the first FTTH compatible plug & play video intercom system. It is the only one that can therefore be installed in an FTTH infrastructure immediately for the creation of multi-service systems as per national legislation.




























## All the features you want for your system

Forget the limits of fake IP systems, with IPure you have an infinite number of features.

### Infinite number of outdoor stations

With IPure you can freely install outdoor audio and audio/video stations without a number limit, therefore ideal for applications ranging from residential structures such as a condominiums, to larger, more complex structures such as a large residence.

## Simultaneous calls from outdoor stations to different indoor stations

Each outdoor audio and audio/video station on the system can call the desired extension even if a call to another extension is in progress.

## Unlimited intercom communication

All the indoor stations installed on the same block/riser and also in different blocks/risers present on the same system can communicate with each other. Of course, intercommunication between indoor stations within the same housing unit is standard.

#### **Standard Relay Services**

For each outdoor station it is possible to activate **2 relay services for opening 2 gates**, for example the driveway and the pedestrian gate, one of which with capacitor discharge capable of opening even the most cumbersome electric locks.

#### Infinite additional services

In addition to actuation of 2 standard outdoor relays, you can install CloudBox and multiply features. For example, the opening of a gate/door where there is no outdoor station, lighting of staircases and any others you may wish.







## IPure Wizard: the software for quick and easy configuration

Forget the difficult operations for configuration of a 2-wire analogue system and complications of the digital systems proposed thus far.

With the IPure Wizard software, configure the system in a flash using a simple wizard, even remotely.





## **Automatic** configuration






## Videx Cloud, services and features aimed at professional installers

### The Videx Cloud is completely free, secure and relies on Amazon Web Services.

The entire infrastructure of services is supported by it: not only the application interface for users, but also advanced features useful for professionals. Simply input your credentials as an installer to access a range of available tasks to simplify your work.

#### **How does the Videx Cloud work?**

After registering the installer profile, simply use the same credentials to access the IPure Wizard software and upload the system to the Cloud.

With the same credentials you can visit the service website and have access to a series of functions from the system, while respecting the sensitive data of the owners:

- · View the list and configurations of the loaded systems;
- Check the number and type of devices installed, assigned MAC addresses and firmware versions;
- · Check parameters and information;
- For each device, display the features available for the App, their type and the custom names assigned;

## Videx Cloud is also designed for the user, with additional features available to them compared to the App.

By registering the user profile, users can access a dedicated page to display the systems paired with the App to which they have access, and the features available for each linked device.

Users can share all the features available with other users via a temporary or permanent QR code and, if they want to restrict access to only some features, create groups of features and share them.

Each time another user scans the shared QR code, the main user will receive a notification email and can potentially block access, in addition to being able to **revoke it at any time**.

#### Freedom of installation

The analogue composition, developed on the support of up to 9 modules, can handle **up to 42** audio and audio/video users.

The digital version is characterised by its compact size that occupy only 2 modules.

## **Extreme strength and durability over time**

The 4000 series push-button panel is vandal resistant with a certified degree of impact resistance up to IK09; the modules are made of AISI 316 satin-finished stainless steel (marine grade) for installations in critical environments exposed to the elements.

#### Weather resistant

Thanks to the neoprene gasket present in the module holder frames, the push-button panel always has a **perfect grip to the wall even on uneven surfaces**.

The **IP65 certification** makes the installation of frames or rain shields unnecessary.

### Reduced installation and maintenance time

The module holder frame has side hinges that allow for the outdoor stations to be opened like a book, thus facilitating installation, inspection and maintenance procedures.

All modules use flat IDC cables for **fast installation**, **thus reducing installation times**.

#### **Multi-protocol**

**RTSP**: Enables integration with third-party NVRs and IP video cameras.

**SIP**: allows for integration with VoiP telephone switchboards.

**HTTP**: allows for the management of all inputs and outputs on third-party management platforms.

#### **Standard RFID reader**

All audio and video modules and the digital panels have an **RFID reader for proximity keys for access control**: it is possible to configure 10,000 955/T key tags or 955/C cards.

#### Visual and acoustic alerts

The audio and video modules are equipped with 4 visual alert LEDs for the hearing impaired, or graphic display in the digital version: busy, call in progress, open communication and open door. Acoustic alerts for the visually impaired indicate a call in progress and busy status.

## **High quality microphone: Hi-Fi intelligibility**

The audio and video modules are equipped with a high quality microphone, the audio balance is perfect and Larsen effect or amplification issues in general are eliminated.


## High resolution colour wide-angle video cameras

The video camera is a **720p (1Mpx) high resolution CMOS colour wide-angle with autoiris.** 

The wide-angle digital autofocus technology and the 4 white LEDs capture a very large viewing area, up to 80° vertically and 170° horizontally, with very high image quality and sharpness even at night.

## **Glossary**

#### FTTH (Fibre To The Home)

The acronym, FTTH, stands for *Fibre To The Home* and identifies ultra-wideband connections where the connection from the transmission hub to the end-user modem is made entirely of fibre optics.

#### **GPON** (Gigabit-Capable Passive Optical Network)

GPON is part of a set of PON standards, which differ according to the maximum overall speed reached within each optical shaft: in the case of GPON the maximum speed is about 2.5 Gbps in download and 1.25 Gbps in upload, shared with a predetermined number of users. The GPON optical network is passive, that is, between the two ends of the network (central network and homes) there are no points that require power supply.

#### **Multi-service system**

Means a passive physical infrastructure, inside the building and consisting of high-speed communication systems up to the network terminals.

#### **CSOE** (Building Optical Service Centre)

The CSOE is a modular box generally installed in the lower part of the building and houses special modules in which the joining of the fibres directed to each apartment takes place and which transport the signals originating from the terminal, from the ROE (Building Optical Distribution Box) and from other multimedia services. It is connected to the real estate units through the fibre optic cables directed to the STOA, ensuring the unique identification of connections intended for them and allowing for interconnection with the technical compartment placed at the top of the building that houses the terminal. The CSOE also houses the optical connectivity of the different broadband operators originating from the ROE.

#### **ROE** (Building Optical Distribution Box)

The ROE, otherwise known as the PTE (Building Termination Point), is the point of separation between the operators' distribution network and the user's network (condominium network).

#### **OLT** (Optical Line Terminal)

The OLT is an optical line terminal used to connect fibre optic trunk lines, it is a device at the input of the external network and at the input of the internal network and functions as a switch or router in a traditional communication network. The main function of the OLT is to control the flow of information through the ODN, going in both directions.

#### **STOA** (Apartment Optical Termination Box)

STOA is the interconnection point between the building's wired network and the apartment itself. It is installed inside each housing unit and creates the arrival point of the fibre optic signals, coming from the CSOE and the starting point of the fibre optic network inside the house. STOA is therefore the point through which the user physically connects to the multi-service optical infrastructure.

#### **HTTP Protocol** (HyperText Transfer Protocol)

In telecommunications and IT, it is an application-level protocol used as the main system for transmitting information on the Web or in a typical client-server architecture.

#### **SIP Protocol** (Session Initiation Protocol)

In telecommunications, SIP means application layer control network protocol used to create, edit, and terminate sessions between one or more participants, these sessions include Internet telephone calls (VoIP), multimedia distributions, and video conferencing. SIP is commonly used to establish or terminate video or voice calls and allows for changing the characteristics of ongoing calls such as IP address and port, invite additional participants and add or delete media streams.

#### RTSP Protocol (Real Time Streaming Protocol)

It is a network protocol used in computer communication and entertainment systems aimed at controlling servers for multimedia streaming, used to establish and manage streaming sessions between servers and clients. Clients send commands to the media server similar to a video recorder, such as play or pause, so as to control the playback of audio/video files distributed by the server in real time.



## **Terms and Conditions of Sale**

#### 1) Definitions

In this document the following words shall have the following meanings:

- a. "Buyer" means the organisation or person who buys Goods;
- b. "Goods" means the items to be supplied to the Buyer by the Seller;

Videx Electronics S.p.A. will be hereafter called "Videx".

#### 2) General Conditions

Any variation to these Terms and Conditions (including any special terms and conditions agreed between the parties) shall be inapplicable unless agreed in writing by Videx.

#### 3) Orders

Any order sent to Videx implies the Buyers acceptance of all the conditions listed into this document. Purchases are finalized when the Buyer receives the order confirmation from Videx. After this confirmation, the order cannot be cancelled unless Videx explicitly agrees in writing.

#### 4) Prices

Price list is to be considered variable as it is subject to variations in production costs which are outside of the control of Videx.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, prices shall be considered ex-works.

#### 5) Retention of Title

Title to the Goods shall not pass to the Buyer until Videx has been paid in full for the Goods.

#### 6) Returned Goods

Returned Goods will not be authorized unless agreed in writing by Videx. Authorized Goods will be accepted only if intact and in their original packaging. Goods not included in the price lists in force will not be accepted.

#### 7) Liability

- videx will not be held responsible for damages arising from incorrect installations which do not comply with the specifications provided or for installations carried out by third parties, or for works carried out by third parties on behalf of the Buyer;
- b. Videx will make good, by repair or by supply of a replacement, defects which, under proper use, appear in the Goods within a period of 12 months after the Goods been sold and arise solely from faulty design, materials or workmanships; always provided that the defective parts have been acknowledged and so declared by Videx;
- c. Videx does not acknowledge any compensation for direct or indirect damages;
- d. All goods must be returned to Videx at Buyer's own expenses, until such time as these are tested Videx admits no liability for their condition;
- e. Videx admits no liabilities for defective parts caused by wear and tear;
- f. All Goods returned for repair must be accompanied by a note in writing stating the nature of the defect claimed, the date of purchase, the invoice number and should be clearly marked with the returning purchaser's full address;
- g. Any returned Goods claimed to be faulty by the Buyer and consequently tested and found to be working correctly by Videx, will be returned to the Buyer and a cost will be charged accordingly.

#### 8) Payment

Unless agreed in writing by Videx, the following general conditions apply:

- a. Payment Terms and Conditions will be specified on the invoice;
- Interest rates as per the banking conditions effective at the time will be charged on top of overdue payments;

#### 9) Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Italy. All the disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Fermo (Italy).
